Notes: The testing process was carried out in compliance to the WCAG 2.0 AA as well as WCAG 2.2 AA guidelines. The product was found to be supportive. As a summary, all the elements and functionalities present in the website are accessible. Accessibility requirements under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) require public entities and certain private organizations to ensure that their digital content is accessible to individuals with disabilities. While the ADA does not prescribe a specific technical standard, the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) are widely recognized as the industry benchmark for web accessibility compliance.

WCAG provides a comprehensive framework for making web content accessible, based on four core principles: content must be perceivable, operable, understandable, and robust.

In addition, Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act aligns closely with WCAG (currently based on WCAG 2.0 Level AA) and establishes similar accessibility requirements for web technologies, including HTML, CSS, JavaScript, and ARIA.

Evaluation Methods Used:

The product was tested against all of the applicable success criteria within the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0 Conformance Level A and AA. The testing methodology included a combination of automated testing, manual testing conducted via paired testing methodology involving two testers, one of them is a non-sighted and the other is a sighted

accessibility expert. This testing methodology ensures that every aspect related to accessibility and user experience is included in our analysis. Below is a list of some of the technologies and environments used:

- Assistive technologies – Screen readers NVDA, Jaws, Voiceover
- Keyboard only interaction, Browser zoom
- Automated tools – Axe, Color Contrast Analyzer
- Browsers – Chrome, Edge, Firefox, Safari
- Accessibility plugins – Axe
- Desktop- Windows 10/ 11, Mac
